WATSONVILLE MAYOR, MAYOR PRO TEM AND COUNCIL MEMBERS ENDORSE LAIRD

WATSONVILLE, CA – John Laird, candidate for California State Senate representing District 17, today announced he has been endorsed by Watsonville Mayor Francisco “Paco” Estrada and Mayor Pro Tem Rebecca Garcia, as well as City Councilmembers Trina Coffman-Gomez, Aurelio Gonzales, Lowell Hurst and Ari Parker.
