LAIRD ENDORSED BY FIVE SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY MAYORS

MONTEREY, CA – John Laird, candidate for State Senate, today announced endorsements by five mayors who represent cities in San Luis Obispo County, including Morro Bay Mayor John Heading, Grover Beach Mayor Jeff Lee, Paso Robles Mayor Steve Martin, Arroyo Grande Mayor Caren Ray Russom, and San Luis Obispo Mayor Heidi Harmon.
